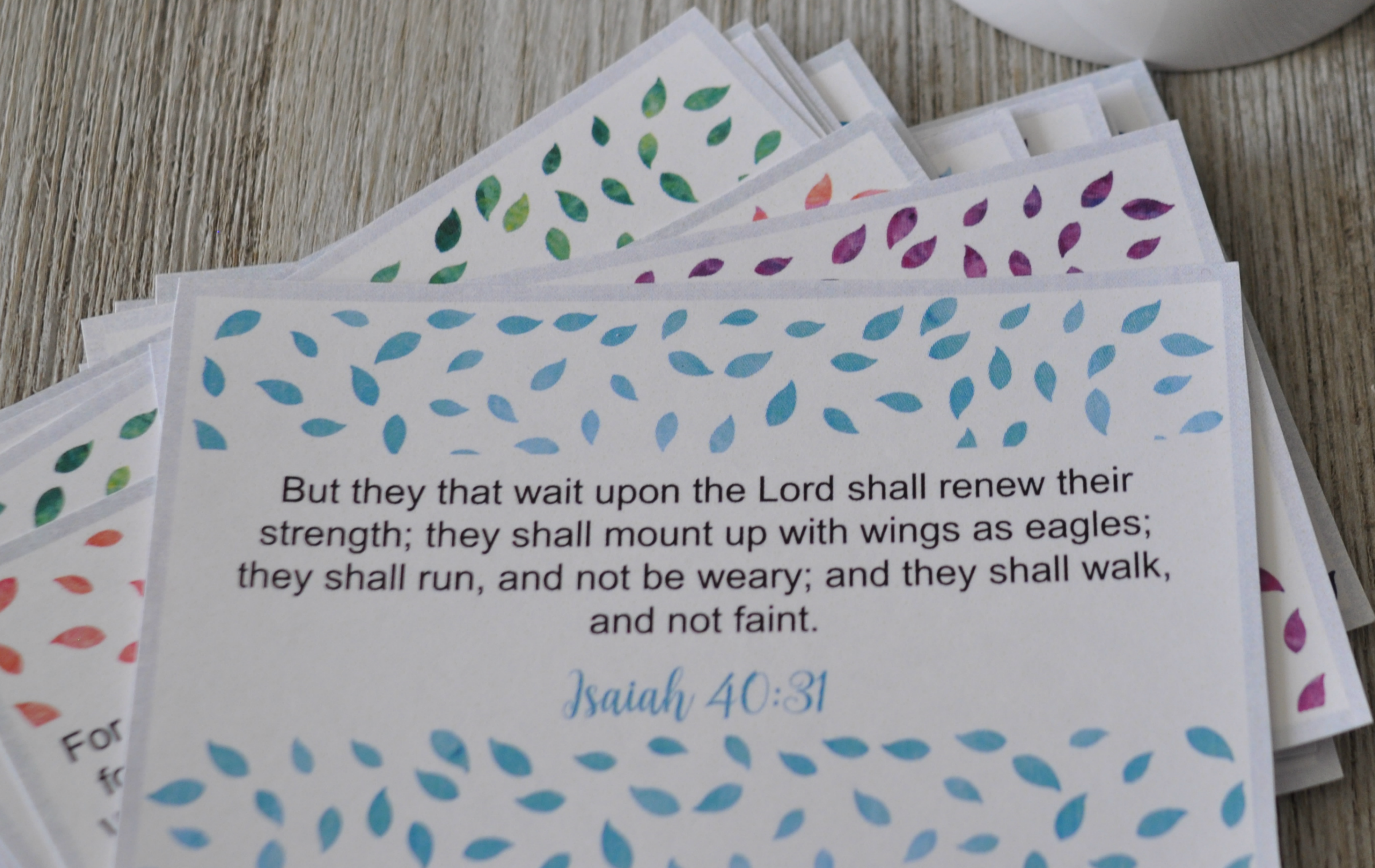

These cards can be used for Bible memory, or you can also just put them in various places to remind yourself of the truth of God's Word throughout the day.

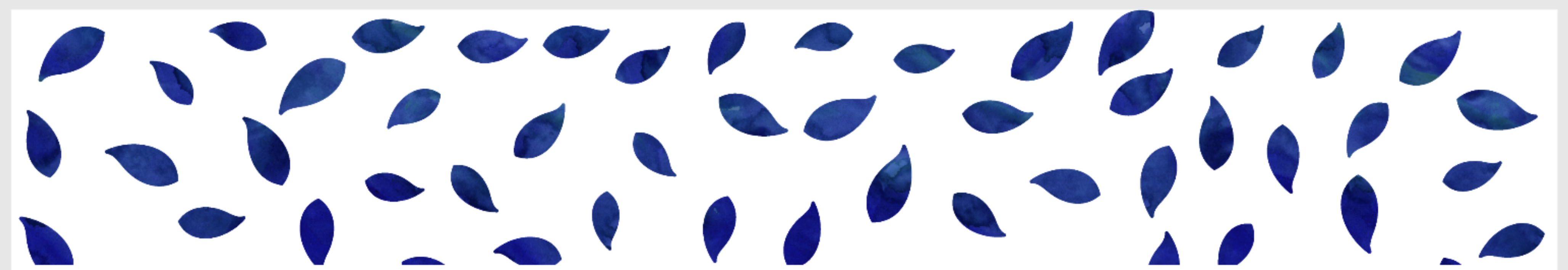
I like to print my cards on cardstock for greater durability. Simply print on your home printer (on 8.5" x 11" paper), cut out, and enjoy!
